### **NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP HONOR SOCIETY AWARDS CHAPTER TO CONCORDIA COLLEGE**

Bronxville, NY—Concordia College-New York has been accepted into the Alpha Sigma Lambda National Honor Society.

Alpha Sigma Lambda is a non-profit organization devoted to the advancement of scholarship and recognition of non-traditional students pursuing higher education. The honor society and its member institutions recognize the special achievement of adult students who accomplish academic excellence while maintaining commitments to family and careers.

The only chapter-based honor society for non-traditional learners, Alpha Sigma Lambda, in partnership with its member colleges and universities, has made major contributions in the areas of student recruitment and retention of adult students.

For the past 18 years, Concordia College has offered adult students three accelerated degree programs: an Associate's degree in Liberal Studies, Bachelor's in Behavioral Sciences, and a Bachelor's in Business Administration. The College emphasizes educational experiences that cultivate personal growth and the development of skills in preparation for a full and productive life.

Concordia College will invite both student and faculty candidates to membership in the honor society during the next several weeks and hold its first induction ceremony in December.
