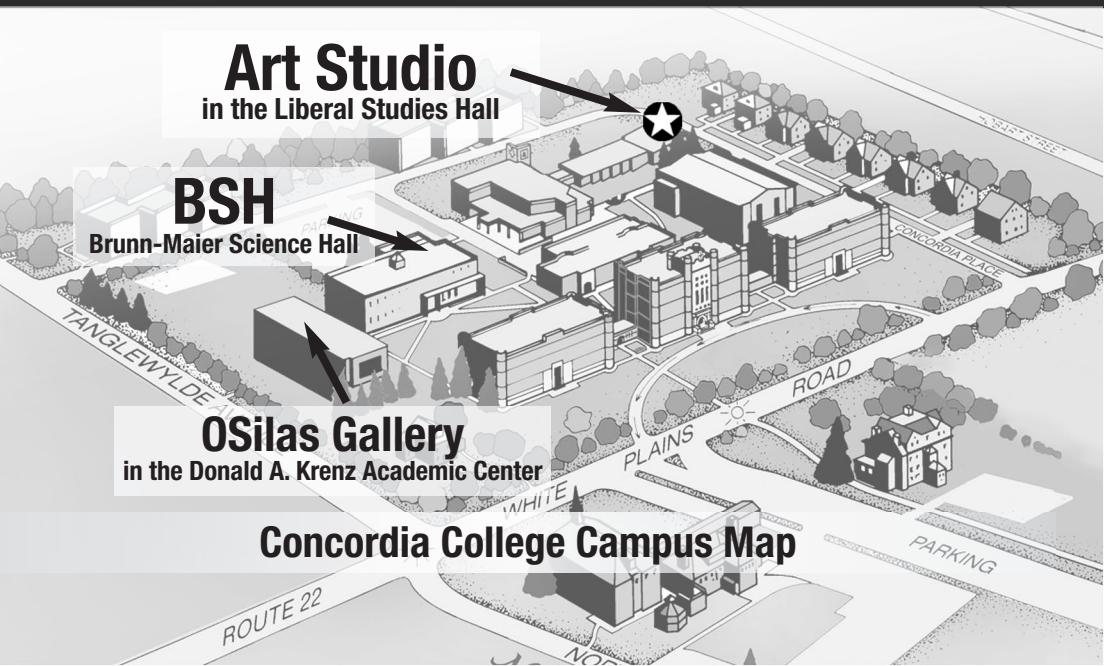

**Jessica Cioffoletti:** BA University at Albany; MS Studio Art, College of New Rochelle. Ms. Cioffoletti is an artist, writer, and art instructor. She currently works for the Westchester Arts Council. Former Rainbow Artist Guild oil instructor for more than six years as well as having a background in private instruction.

**JC English:** Classically trained in oil, pastel, and drawing, Ms. English apprenticed to Daniel E. Greene and received training at the Art Students League, NYC. Her work has been included in juried exhibitions at the Salmagundi Club, Hudson Valley Art Association, Audubon Artists, New Haven Paint & Clay Club, Allied Artists, and the American Artists Professional League, Inc.

**Alisa Garabo:** BA Ceramics, University of Hartford; MA Art Education, College of New Rochelle. Ms. Garabo comes to us through the Clay Art Center in Port Chester. She has taught ceramics in area summer camp programs and currently teaches art at Immaculate Conception School in Tuckahoe.

**Samantha Hanley:** BA Art History, Fordham University; MA Art & Art Education, NYU. Former elementary school art teacher at St. Mary's Star of the Sea in City Island, NY; Learning through an Expanded Arts Program in NYC; and Young at Art in Scarsdale.

**Lisa Hofflich:** BA Broadcast Journalism, NYU. A former television news producer for CNBC, WNBC, EXTRA, and *Consumer Reports*, Ms. Hofflich has an extensive background in digital media and has worked with Adobe Photoshop for the past ten years.

**Marygrace Killip:** BA Illustration & Art History, Syracuse University. Ms. Killip has worked in the fashion industry as a handbag designer for major department stores, and as a freelance artist specializing in portraits and hand-painted items. She has taught art in after-school enrichment programs in Eastchester and Tuckahoe.

**Filadi Kulla:** BA Concordia College—New York. Mr. Kulla is a commissioned oil portrait artist and experienced instructor, specializing in drawing and painting classes for adults and children. He is a former Rainbow Artist Guild oil instructor and currently works as a Graphic Designer at Concordia College.

**Jackie Meier:** MFA in painting from Pratt Institute, Brooklyn, NY; studied at Boston College as well as California College of Arts in San Francisco. She is represented by Kenise Barnes Fine Art in Larchmont and Janet Kurnatowski in Brooklyn. She has lectured at Brigham Young University and was a visiting artist for a graduate painting seminar at Pratt Institute.

**Christy Morejon:** AA Fine Arts, Westchester Community College; BA Psychology and MA Art Education, College of New Rochelle. Ms. Morejon is an artist, experienced art instructor, and a former art teacher at The Chapel School and Summer at Concordia. She has been a tenured art teacher at Albert Leonard Middle School for the last four years.

- Class size limited to 8-10 students.
- Annual registration fee is \$35 per student and is non-refundable.
- Class fee: \$350 for first class, \$315 for additional classes for individual or family for curricular year. Cost for Summer Camp Classes are as noted.
- There is no registration fee for Concordia Summer Camp courses. A non-refundable deposit of \$150 is required for each session.
- We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment. Both tuition and registration fee will be fully refunded. No refunds for withdrawals after classes begin. If a class is cancelled due to weather or teacher absence, it will be re-scheduled.
- Registration due: Session III: January 13; Session IV: March 12. Payment is required to reserve space.
