## BIOS

### Kyle Grandilli (FR) -- Port Colbourne, Ontario, Canada

Concordia College received Kyle's signed NLI on May 3, making him the first signed recruit for our golf program.

Kyle is from Port Colborne, Ontario, and comes to us with an impressive golf and academic resume. A 3.75 student at Lakeshore Catholic HS, he won a CJGA event (the Kaeneff Junior Series), finished second at another CJGA event (a Triangular Cup qualifier), and won the Niagara Juvenile.

His other golf accomplishments include finishing 17th on the Niagara Junior Tour in 2008; finishing 4th on the Niagara Boys Tour in 2007; and qualifying for the Canadian Junior National Championship in 2009.

In Kyle's most recent junior tournament, the 14th Annual PARS Florida International Junior Golf Championship at PGA GC in Port St. Lucie, FL, in December, 2009, Kyle stormed his way (81-79-75) to an impressive top ten finish in a field filled with top juniors from all over the world.

### Lorenz Kolmeder (FR) -- Bavaria, Germany

Lorenz, who turned 20 this August, is the 81st ranked amateur in Bavaria. He was our second commit.

He is from Mainburg, a town in the district of Kelheim, in Bavaria, Germany.

Lorenz finished in the Top 20 at the Bavaria State Championships in 2009, and averaged 75.12 for 40 rounds on the Bavarian Senior Class Amateur Tour (ages 19-35) in 2009. His best rounds on this tour included five sub-70 rounds, highlighted by a six-under 66 in a Bavarian senior class amateur event on November 20, 2009.

Jeffrey Schaller (SO) - Kingston, NY

We were able to secure a late commitment from Jeff Schaller of Ulster CC. This was a big score for us. Jeff qualified for the New York State Open this summer and played great in late August at Bethpage Black, shooting a 79 with a U.S. Open course set-up.

Jeff attended and played one year (2009-10) at Ulster CC and earned 27 credits with a 2.9 cumulative GPA.

Here is his brief golf bio from there:

"In 2009-10, Ulster CC freshman Jeff Schaller (Kingston, NY) led Ulster to a second place finish at the 2010 NJCAA Region XV Golf Tournament at the Philip J. Rotella GC in Suffern, NY, on May 5-6. Schaller finished second among individuals with a two-day score of 76-75 -- 151, which earned him All-Region honors and a trip to the NJCAA Division III National Tournament.

Schaller also help lead Ulster to the 2010 Mid Hudson Conference (NJCAA) championship, and finished second on the conference player of the year points list."
